CGEIT Application

Essay: Description of IT Governance Work Experience

Please describe below in narrative form, and in your own words, your experience managing, providing advisory and/or assurance services, and/or otherwise supporting the governance of an enterprise's information technology. Emphasize your experience relating to the development, monitoring and/or maintenance of an IT governance framework (CGEIT domain 1). Include specific examples of your most recent roles, responsibilities and assignments as they apply to each domain in which you are claiming experience. Do not copy or repeat task statements from the CGEIT job practice. Please provide a minimum of 250 words and be as specific as possible (500 words maximum)

- **Very short professional summary (25 words), then**
- **Discuss activity from a *governance* perspective. Use the essay to demonstrate your understanding of CGEIT domains**
 - E.g., management reporting vs. mere 'monitoring' of control
- **Discuss activity related to each domain in turn. Framework is mandatory**
 - Describe projects and your role in them
